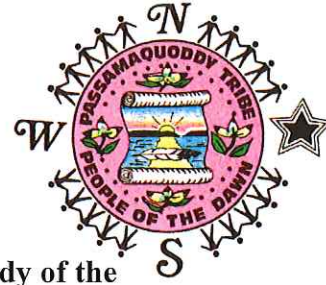

**Resolution # 02/23/2017 of the Governing Body of the
Passamaquoddy Tribe Joint Tribal Council**

- Whereas,** the Passamaquoddy Tribe is a federally recognized sovereign Indian Tribe having Reservations at Indian Township and Pleasant Point; and
- Whereas,** the Passamaquoddy Tribal Chiefs and Councils of each reservation are the duly Authorized and elected governing body of the Passamaquoddy Tribe; and
- Whereas,** Tribal fisherman will pick gear with NO changes.
- Whereas,** March 2nd, 2017 Noon (12:00 PM) deadline for applications.
- Whereas,** 10 lbs. cap per license, fishing will cease when individual permit holders reach 10 lbs. , OR, the tribal quota is reached whichever occurs first.
- Whereas,** Reporting deadline of June 16, 2017 @ 4 P.M. or you will be ineligible for 2018 season, and any violations of JTC rules will result in 2018 suspension.
- Whereas,** \$50.00 non-refundable reinstatement fee for applicants that were deemed non-compliant by the JTC rules and local rules, due by March 2, 2017 at noontime. This fee is in addition to the \$25.00 application fee.
- Whereas,** Tribal members that fail to report at either reservation from the 2016 deadlines will only be eligible for 5 lbs quota (cap) and dip only.
- Whereas,** 16 Year old minimum to get license.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT

In the event of a conflict, the provisions contained in this Resolution shall prevail, all other existing provisions remain in effect.

CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned Clerk of the Joint Tribal Council of the Passamaquoddy Tribe, do hereby certify that a meeting of the Joint Tribal Council of the Passamaquoddy Tribe was held at the Indian Township Passamaquoddy Reservation on February 23, 2017 and do further certify that a quorum of the Joint Tribal Council of the Passamaquoddy Tribe consisting of either the Sakom/Chief or the Leptanet/Vice-Chief of each Reservation and not fewer than eight voting members, including at least four voting members from each Reservation, was determined by a roll call taken and recorded at the beginning of the meeting and present at the time of the action certified hereby, and that the foregoing Resolution was circulated in writing to all members of the Joint Tribal Council present at the said meeting prior to being voted upon at the meeting, and that the foregoing Resolution was duly moved, seconded and adopted by the affirmative vote of 7 members, who at the time of the vote constituted a majority of the 10 members of the Joint Tribal Council then present and voting.
